



An upgrade from MailXServer 3.1b to 3.2a is available.

Changes are as follows:

- 1) Added user authentication. User rights works on two levels.
 - a. Level 1: The administrator (or user with similar rights) can assign page rights to a user. This will enable a user to only access specified pages.
 - b. Level 2: Rule (domain / address) rights can be assigned to a user. This means that a user will only be able to view and manage specific rules (domains /addresses).

In an ISP environment you could assign rights to every user to manage his/her own rules. If the user has access to the log files the user will only be able to view, analyze and release his/her own emails.

NOTE: The default user is admin with password admin.

- 2) Queue Management. New features to the MailXServers queue management were added.
 - a. Delete only selected email
 - b. Delete selected emails where the **from address** are similar to the selected emails.
 - c. Delete selected emails where the **to address** are similar to the selected emails. If an email has multiple recipients the email will be ignored.
 - d. Delete selected emails where the **from domain** are similar to the selected emails.
 - e. Delete selected emails where the **to domain** are similar to the selected emails. If an email has multiple recipients the email will be ignored.
 - f. Flush only selected messages
 - g. Flush selected emails where the **from address** are similar to the selected emails.
 - h. Flush selected emails where the **to address** are similar to the selected emails. If an email has multiple recipients the email will be ignored.
 - i. Flush selected emails where the **from domain** are similar to the selected emails.
 - j. Flush selected emails where the **to domain** are similar to the selected emails. If an email has multiple recipients the email will be ignored.

Queued emails can be sorted according to the Queue ID, Date Sent, From, To, Subject, Size and Status fields.

- 3) A comment (description) fields was added to the Static RBL Blacklist and Whitelist fields.
- 4) A comment (description) field was added to the Sender and Recipient rules.
- 5) You can directly edit a rule from the “View Rules Summary” page by clicking on the relevant rule.
- 6) Other minor changes and fixes.
