



Minor upgrade from MailXServer 3.2a to 3.2b

A) GUI updates

1) Reports → Query Wizard:

- a. Added ">", "<" and "NOT *Like*" to Query Wizard. Remember that all fields can contain text. Depending on your data in your database you might have to use the "NOT *Like*" feature in combination with ">" or "<" to extract numeric information. E.g. you want to extract all spam scores higher than 15 as follows:

2) Reports → Summary

- a. Fixed date issues on the summary support

3) System → User Management

- a. Added support for Rules Superusers. These users will have the exact same rule privileges as the admin user. Please note that you can still limit the pages a Rule Superuser can view under the "Edit Page Allow" section. Any user can be assigned Rule Superuser rights by selecting the "All Rules (Rule Superuser)" tick under the "Edit Rules Allow" section.
- b. Added page rights as follows:

4) Reports → Top Entries

- a. Fixed drill down issues to limit the drill down to only show correct domain or rule records.
- b. Changed the drill down to show records only between specified dates

- 5) Mail Server → Mail Queue
 - a. Set "Flush Selected Mail" as default

- 6) Other minor changes and fixes.

B) Engine Updates

- 1) Added support for a RAM-drive work directory that drastically enhances the performance of MailXserver on busy servers.
